## Scope

This bibliography lists publications pertaining to child maltreatment authored by Murray Arnold Straus, Ph.D. (1926-2016). Dr. Straus was an American professor of sociology at the University of New Hampshire. He is best known for creating the conflict tactics scale, one of the most widely used research instruments in family violence. His research focused on families, corporal punishment, and intimate partner violence with an emphasis on cross-national comparisons. Dr. Straus founded the Family Research Laboratory at the University of New Hampshire and was also a founding editor of the peer-review academic journals *Teaching Sociology* and *Journal of Family Issues*.
